The Fountain Hills Women's Club was formally organized in 1974, just four years after the founding of Fountain Hills itself.

The club was incorporated as a non-profit organization in 1976 and a fund was established to purchase a club building. In 1988, the club voted to give the \$100,000 Building Fund monies to the Fountain Hills Community Center.

Since its founding, the Fountain Hills Women's Club has welcomed women of all ages who are committed to maintaining our tradition of friendship and community service to Fountain Hills.

Annual dues for members are \$25, payable in January. New club member dues are \$30 to include a personalized magnetic name tag. There is an additional cost for monthly catered luncheons and special events.

We also host an annual Fashion Show & Luncheon each spring, which is our primary fundraiser.

- Providing scholarships for women, age 23 and older who live or work in Fountain Hills, to help them continue their education and advance their careers
